

Some of the issues in his evidence:

Kleros pays for bugs (No we only pay for smart contract bugs, only in bounty periods, not open-ended)

He overstates the potential loss of profit. (Maximum he could win was **0.868 ETH** only if the counterparty funds the appeal as well and only if jurors rule in favor of Mente's side. And maximum he could lose was **1.736 ETH** . So on average, his expected return is negative. So we actually caused him to avoid losing money.)

There is no such thing as %100 bug-free software, you can only prove bugs existence but not their inexistence. We are not liable for any UI bugs.

Appeal stake funds were locked because of the inexistence of the “withdraw funds” button. Wrong, you can always withdraw it by interacting with the contract directly. And not four days, but two days at most.

UI bugs don't undermine Kleros' systems bribe resistance, you can always directly interact with the contract. UI and smart contracts are separate things. Kleros is a system on the Ethereum network.
