This image does not clearly show a cat and obviously goes against the standing guideline which states that "a picture **must clearly display** a doge or a cat."

It is quite obvious that the image does not clearly show whether the animal is in fact a doge, or a cat.

Furthermore, the guideline states that "hidden doges or cats will not be considered as valid if a normal observer would not be able to see it without help."

While the requester did indeed post other images which should go to prove his position, the need to add further proof goes directly against the aforementioned part of the guideline, more particularly the part about *not being able to see it without help*, since the animal is obviously not in plain sight.

This position has already been iterated upon in the article here.

It is our position that because of these breaches of the guideline, the receiver should not be entitled to the 50 ETH prize.
