

Primary Document for Insurance Data Submissions

Estimating the risk of motor driver accidents is an important step required while creating related insurance products. In this token curated registry, the insurance company wishes to obtain data, and models based on such data, that indicate the relationship between the pure premium (amount corresponding to losses and loss-adjustment expenses) per year and the amount of miles driven per year in geographic zones.

Conditions for an acceptable data only submission:

- The data must be published by a credible source.
- Only data that pertains to the following geographic regions is considered:
 - France (city) OR
 - France (rural) OR
 - UK (city) OR
 - UK (rural)

Data sets must be drawn from exactly one of these categories. For example, data sets that mix data from the France (city) and France (rural) categories should not be considered.

- Data must not have already been submitted.
- Data does not have to be cleaned, but it does have to be sufficiently readable that jurors are reasonably able to evaluate the criteria of this primary document.
- Enough data must be present that one can reasonably use the data to construct a useful model for the relationship between pure premium per year and amount of miles driven per year.
- The link to the data in the submission should be accessible free of charge.
